

## **2016-2017 CITIZENS NOMINATING COMMITTEE**

### **PRESENTATION QUESTIONS FOR NOMINEES**

Adopted at the Organization Meeting December 4, 2016

The Citizens Nominating Committee (CNC) requests that nominees for Village of Scarsdale Trustee or Mayor appear in person before the Citizens Nominating Committee and describe their qualifications, including coverage of the following topics:

1. What qualities and special skills do you bring from your background and experience, which would be of value as Village Trustee/Mayor?
2. Give us an example of civic work you have done of which you are most proud.
3. What is your understanding of the role of a Village Trustee/Mayor relative to that of the Village staff, community, and other Trustees?
4. How would you approach the time commitment necessary to devote to the role of Village Trustee/Mayor?
5. Please share other information that you consider relevant.

**Duration of Presentation:** Up to ten minutes. A Non-Voting CNC Member will give remaining time warnings at two minutes, at one minute and at thirty seconds.

**Format:** Nominees will address the CNC. The CNC shall not ask any follow-up questions during the presentation.

**Note regarding potential follow-up question(s):** The 2016-2017 CNC adopted the 2016 Procedure Committee's recommendation that the CNC be permitted to ask a limited number of follow-up questions, either general to all nominees or specific to individual nominees. Written questions shall be developed by the CNC with advice and guidance from the Chair and in compliance with the provisions of the Non-Partisan Resolution. The subsequent questioning of the nominee(s) shall be conducted in person by at least two people selected by the CNC to verify the response(s).
